

Tree Cleanup and Chainsaw Safety Training Program

As a result of the recent hurricanes, we have received resources to offer Emergency Tree Cleanup and Chainsaw Safety Trainings in SC. This training is designed for first responders and other workers who clear storm-downed trees, but will benefit anyone who operates a chainsaw. The training will take workers from personal protective equipment (PPE), to site-assessment, to safe saw start. Training will include employer responsibilities, employee rights, electrical hazards, power tools (chainsaw), slips, trips, falls, and PPE for safe chainsaw use. ISA Arborist Credit is available.

Training is limited to 35 participants.
