Curriculum Changes That May Affect You or Your Department

Effective with the course date insert:

Course 2727, Hazardous Materials Awareness is a mandatory prerequisite for Hazardous Materials Operations. Course 2727 is available in two formats, one is an on-line course delivery and the other is an 8-hour traditional classroom delivery. All students registering for the on-line version of Course 2727 will use the following course code and section number on their registration form: 2727-12001. Traditional course students will use the course code and section number as published for their course selection. On-line students will receive additional information on accessing the on-line training site with their course confirmation.

Course 2728, Hazardous Materials Operations, is 32 hours in length. and meets the prerequisite requirement for course 1153, NFPA Firefighter I. Students with the old 2722 course, Hazardous Materials Operations, and course 1136, Flammable Liquids and Gas Firefighting, will not need to take the new 2728 course in order to meet the prerequisite requirement for 1153.

Course 1136, Flammable Liquids and Gas Firefighting, will no longer be a prerequisite for 1153, NFPA Firefighter I. Course 1136 will remain a current active course available through the Fire Academy's delivery system. The course has been rewritten and only deals with flammable liquids and gases. All reference to hazardous materials that do not involve flammable liquids and gases have been removed. It should be considered an advanced class for students completing the 1153 and 1154 programs.

Course 3400, Aircraft Rescue Firefighting, is now a five day program (instead of six days). Course curriculum will remain the same along with all course objectives.



Challenge Opportunity Continues

Challenge course 1152 (Course Code 4700)

This special challenge will apply only to in-state current firefighters who have completed firefighter training in the past which can be documented to be equivalent to the old 1121 Course (fundamentals of firefighting course of at least 60 hours documented by a certificate of completion). A fire department in-house certificate or letter signed by the chief of the department reflecting 60 hours of basic firefighter training will also meet this requirement. The certificate or letter must be attached to the registration form.

To be eligible to challenge the 1152 written exam and Practical Skills, the firefighter:

- a. Must have documented proof of being a volunteer or paid member of a fire department for at least a year prior to January 1, 2011.
- b. Must be in good standing with current department and registered as a firefighter under the Firefighter Registration Act.
- c. Must register for desired testing session at least 30 days prior to the testing session date.

Students registering for this challenge test must understand that they are responsible for all material covered in our 1152 Course, Fundamentals of Firefighting. This includes reading material, as well as practical skill development. Students may also review (other than our IFSTA curriculum) manuals from other sources such as; Jones and Bartlett, Delmar and Brady Publishing. All practical skills are evaluated using the IFSTA curriculum and as taught in our program. The 1152 Performance Task Manual for all practical skills is available on our Web site at, www.scfa.state.sc.us. Students must score a minimum of 70 percent on the written exam and successfully complete all random skills. Students are given a second attempt during the practical skill session. This second attempt is immediate with no “coaching” or remedial training from the evaluator. A single retest of the written exam will be allowed. Allow a full day for this challenge process.

Challenging Firefighter I (Course Code 4701)

Prior to January 1, 2011, students must have at least 8 years of service or greater.

This special challenge will apply only to in-state current firefighters who have completed 1152, or have been given equivalency, Course 2722, Hazardous Material Operations, or its equivalent as determined by the SCFA. Please attach copies of certificates to be considered as equivalent for Hazardous Materials Operations to the registration form. Attach copies of your current First Aid and CPR cards.

This challenge will only be allowed January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2012.

To be eligible to challenge the State Certification Exam for the endorsed ISFAC Firefighter Level I, the firefighter:

- a. Must have the Fire Chief Verification Package attached to registration form. This package is available for downloading from our Web site at www.scfa.state.sc.us.
- b. Must meet the above prerequisites and must register for desired testing session at least 30 days prior to the testing session date.

Students registering for this challenge test must understand that they are responsible for all material covered in the 1153 course, Firefighter I. This includes all reading material and skills covered in 1152 and other prerequisite courses as well. Students may also review (other than our IFSTA curriculum) manuals from other sources such as; Jones and Bartlett, Delmar and Brady Publishing. Students must score a minimum of 70 percent on the written exam. A second retest will be granted, if unsuccessful on the first attempt. This retest can be scheduled after grades are released following the first exam. A random skill evaluation session will not be required. Applicable documentation to support this package must be on file within the department. Allow four hours for this exam.

Challenging Firefighter II (Course Code 4702)

Prior to January 1, 2011, students must have at least 8 years of service or greater.

This special challenge will apply only to in-state current firefighters who are certified to the level of Firefighter I, and completed the Academy's Course 3330, Auto Extrication. Equivalent courses are not accepted for course 3330.

This challenge will only be allowed from January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2012.

To be eligible to challenge the State Certification Exam for the endorsed ISFAC Firefighter Level II, the firefighter:

- a. Must have the Fire Chief Verification Package attached to the registration form. This package is available for downloading from our Web site at www.scfa.state.sc.us.
- b. Must meet the above prerequisites and register for the desired testing session at least 30 days prior to the testing session date.

Students registering for this challenge test are responsible for all material covered in the 1154 course, Firefighter II. This includes all reading material and skills covered in Course 1153 and other prerequisite courses as well. Students may also review (other than our IFSTA curriculum) manuals from other sources such as; Jones and Bartlett, Delmar and Brady Publishing. Students must score a minimum of 70 percent on the written exam. A second retest will be granted, if unsuccessful on the first attempt. This retest can be scheduled after the grade is released following the first attempt. A random skill evaluation session will not be required. Applicable documentation to support this statement must be on file within the department. Allow four hours for this exam.

Challenging Fire Officer I (Course Code 4703)

Prior to January 1, 2011, students must have at least 8 years of service or greater.

This special challenge will apply only to in-state current firefighters who have certified to the level of Firefighter II and completed the Academy's Course 4171, Fire Instructor I or equivalent course.

This challenge will only be allowed from January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2012.

In addition to Item I, to be eligible to challenge the State Certification Exam and Practical Skills for the endorsed ISFAC Fire Officer Level I, the firefighter:

- a. Must have documented proof of being a volunteer or paid member of a fire department for the past 8 years.
- b. Must be in good standings with current department and registered as a firefighter under the Firefighter Registration Act.
- c. Must meet the above prerequisites and register for desired testing session at least 30 days prior to the testing session date.

Students registering for this challenge test are responsible for all material covered in the 2100 Course, Fire Officer I. This includes all reading material as well as practical skill development. Students may also review (other than our IFSTA curriculum) manuals from other sources such as; Jones and Bartlett, Delmar and Brady Publishing. All practical skills are evaluated using the IFSTA curriculum and as taught in our program. Students must score a minimum of 70 percent on the written test and successfully complete all random skills. Students are offered a second attempt during the practical skill session. This second attempt is immediate with no "coaching" or remedial training from the evaluator. Students will be allowed one retest on the written exam. Please allow an 8-hour day for this challenge process.

Special registration and special evaluation days for 4700 and 4703 will also be part of this program. These special evaluation days are available within this course date insert. For 4701 and 4702 that only require challenging of the written exam, you may register for one of the certification test dates listed in this insert. Please check the applicable region for dates and times convenient for you. Other dates may be announced by other means, such as e-mail, mail-outs or on our Web site. Requests for special testing dates may be made through the applicable regional office based on numbers and needs. If you are interested in one of the challenges, please meet the prerequisites in order to register for that challenge process.

All registrations will be reverified by academy staff. To properly register, include the specific course code. This special challenge process has its own special course codes for tracking purposes. The following are the course codes for each challenge:

While registering for a challenge session, include the correct course code and section number on the registration form. This program is separate from our normal challenge process associated with our equivalency program. This program is strictly for in-state firefighters who meet the requirements of registration as outlined in each challenge process. Please review each challenge process to ensure eligibility and provide documentation to support the registration form. Students must register at least 30 days prior to the testing session date. In addition, two of the challenges, 4701 and 4702, require a “Fire Chief Verification Package” be attached to your registration in lieu of having to take the practical skill (hands-on) portion of the evaluation. If the registration form does not have the “Fire Chief Verification Package” attached, it will be returned. As stated above, this verification package can be downloaded from our Web site at www.scfa.state.sc.us. This verification package contains a form that the Chief of the Department and the student taking the challenge exam must sign. It is recommended that a complete copy of this package be kept onfile at the fire department. Only Section 2 of this form will be on file at the Fire Academy. For the 4700 and 4703 courses, this form is not required since the challenge process requires both the written exam and the successful completion of practical skills during that session. This special challenge program is only valid from January 1, 2011 until December 31, 2012. During this time period, only one retest attempt will be allowed. If the second attempt is also unsuccessful the student must complete the regular program. The Fire Academy’s normal limit of 180 days for retest does not apply to this special challenge process.

Preparing for a Practical Certification Exam

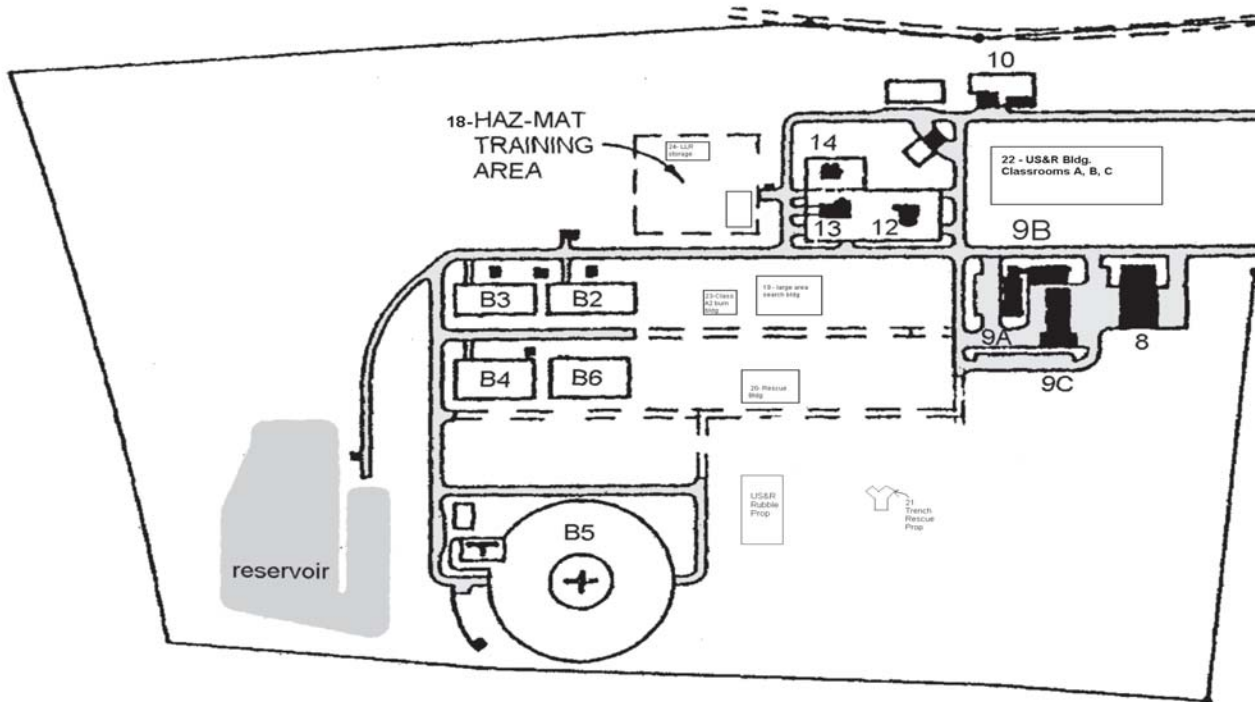
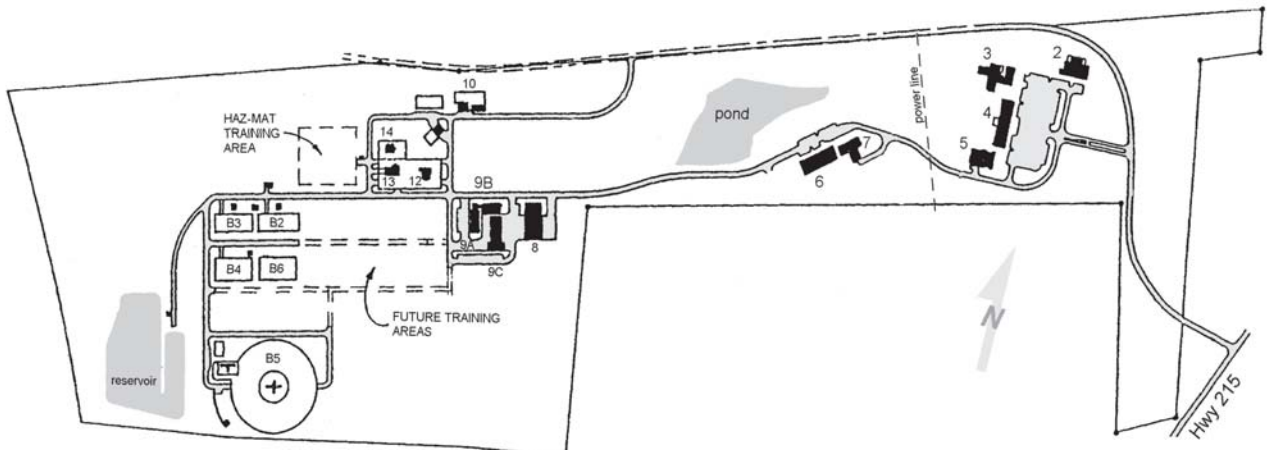
Practical certification exams are conducted at the conclusion of certain courses. The Firefighter I Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1153 - NFPA Firefighter I*. The Firefighter II Practical Certification Exam is conducted at the conclusion of course *1154 - NFPA Firefighter II*; the 1002 - Driver/Operator-Pumper practical exams are given at the conclusion of courses *1220 - Pump Operations I*, *1221 - Pump Operations II* and course *1210 - Emergency Vehicle Driver Training*; and the practical exam for Instructor I is conducted at the end of course *4171 - Fire Instructor I*. Based on this evaluation method, these courses are prerequisites to completing the written certification examination. Students who are successful in the course should be well prepared to take the practical skills exam. However, since the practical skills examinations contain several objectives, which they may be asked to perform, students should be prepared to perform all of the manipulative or practical objectives listed in the NFPA standard for that certification level. Practical skills tests are graded on a pass/fail system with a passing score required for successful completion of the certification exam. Passing means that the student performed the skill correctly, while failing means that the student performed the skill unsafely or to the point of being ineffective. Each student will be given two attempts to perform each required skill during the same test session. Should the student not receive a pass rating on the initial attempt, he/she will be eligible for an immediate second attempt. Students will be retested only on the skill that was not performed satisfactorily after two attempts. One retest opportunity is allowed for students failing to meet the minimum score for a practical skills exam. Any student failing to complete the second attempt will be required to retest the failed skill at a later date. The student must wait at least 30 days before retesting. Failing the retest requires the student to retake the entire training program before being eligible again for retesting.

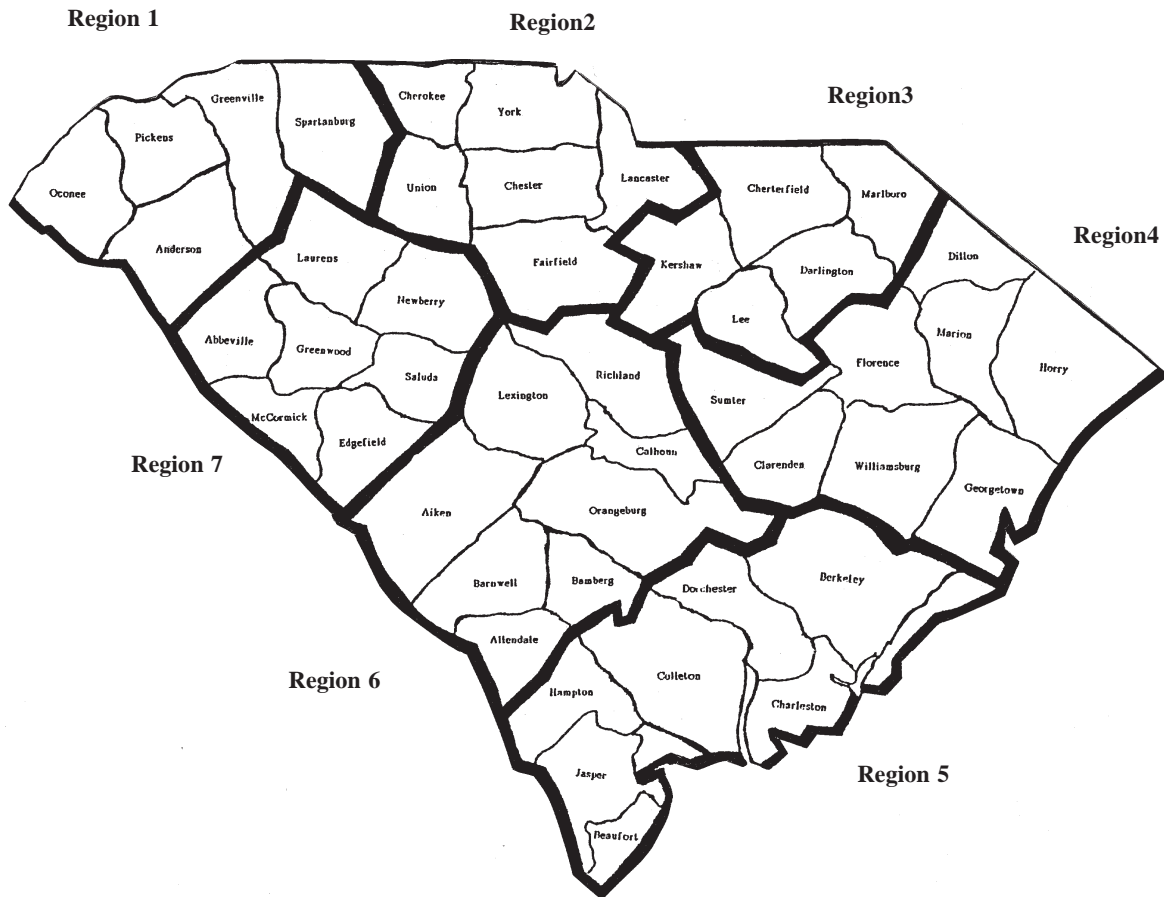

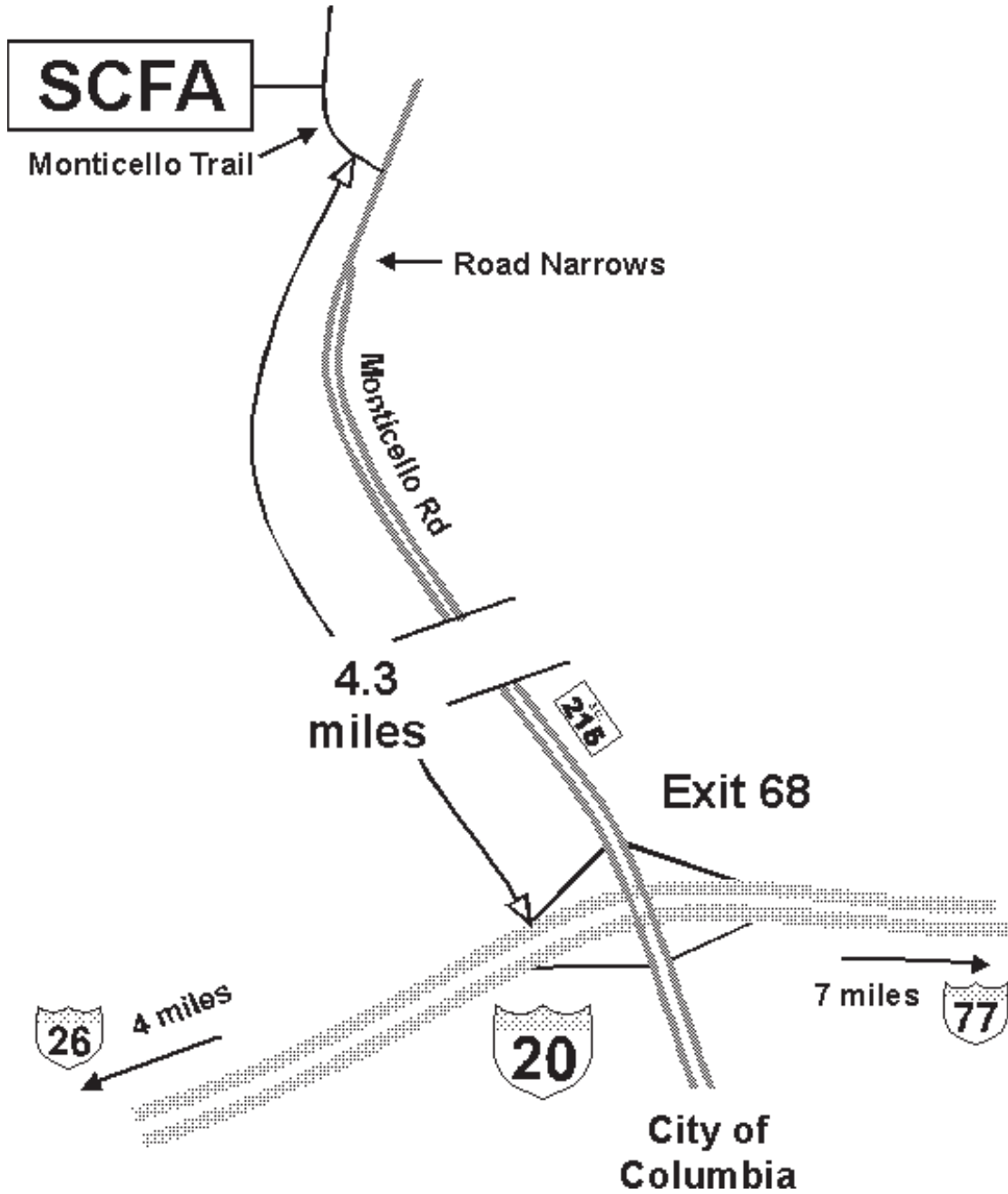
