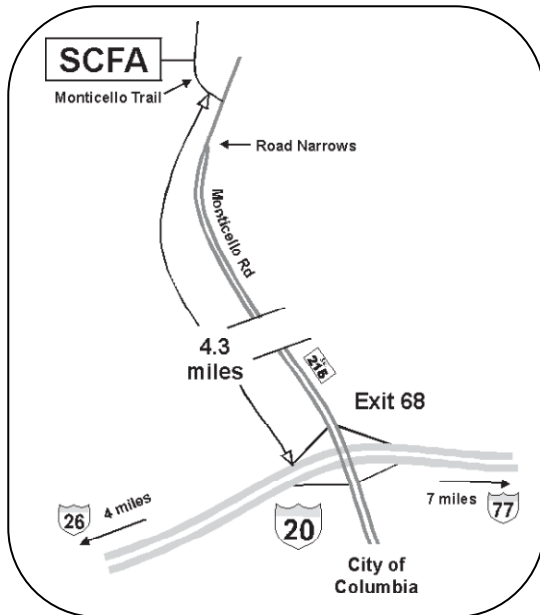

The “Building Construction Related to the Fire Service” course uses traditional classroom delivery for the four-day class to complete the 14 modules and activities. Students will be provided with all class materials.

To help improve this course, students taking this new pilot program will be asked to provide feedback during the course evaluation segment.

The course will be taught by SCFA instructors with a background in building construction.

Students successfully completing the course requirements will receive a certificate.

Information gained in the course goes above and beyond the NFA Building Construction courses 2130 and 2132.

### Building Construction Related to the Fire Service

This pilot course provides students with basic instruction regarding how buildings are designed, constructed and how it relates to emergency operations.

In addition to basic construction principles, a new emphasis is placed on firefighter safety, newer types of construction that may be difficult to identify, and green construction principles.

Each chapter begins with a Case History that analyzes an event and emphasizes lessons learned.

Fire inspectors, pre-incident planners, fire-ground commanders, investigators, and firefighters will gain useful and valuable information in this new course.
