Commander sections: March 13-17 with Spartanburg ESA or April 3-7 with Mt. Pleasant FD.



These 40 hour sections are based on NFPA 472, Standard for Professional Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials Incidents, and successful students will receive certification to Pro Board and IFSAC through Alabama Fire College.

These sections supply the Incident Commander with the knowledge and skills to perform his/her role as the person responsible for decisions relating to the management of the incident at releases or potential releases of hazardous materials. The student will learn about personal protective clothing, decontamination, branch functions with the Incident Management System, and the overall tactics to properly mitigate a hazardous materials incident.
